

## MS4 Program and Municipal Departments

CEO- Supervisors & Mayors – *Sign NOI, Annual Reports, are ultimately responsible for the entire program*

Municipal Board/Council – *Public Participation, adopts laws, and other sections as they see fit*

Municipal Clerk – *Public Notices, education*

Justices – *Will see violators of Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination Law and possibly Erosion Control and Stormwater Management violators.*

Attorney – *Process local laws, prosecute violators*

Building Department – *Likely permitors and inspectors for erosion control, Post-Construction, education*

Planning Board – *Part of the Erosion Control and Stormwater Management review team*

Engineering – *Also part of the Erosion Control and Stormwater Management review team, possibly permitting and inspection*

Utilities – *Possibly part of Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, Post-Construction, Education, Good Housekeeping*

Parks & Recreation – *Good Housekeeping, Education*

Streets/Highways – *Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, Post-Construction, Good Housekeeping, Education*

Public Works – *Post-Construction, Good Housekeeping, Education*

Youth – *Education*

Buildings/Maintenance – *Good Housekeeping*

Police/Public Safety - *Good Housekeeping, some possible enforcement*

**Measure 2 – Public Involvement**

CEO, Board/Council, Planning Board, Building Inspector

CEO/Board/Council, Utilities, Streets/Highways, Police/Public Safety, Attorney, Justices,

**Measure 4 – Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control**

CEO/Board/Council, Planning Board, Building Department, Engineering, Attorney, Justices

**Measure 5 – Post Construction Stormwater Management**

CEO/Board/Council, Planning Board, Building Department, Engineering, Utilities, Streets/Highways, Public Works

**Measure 6 – Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping for Municipal Operations**

Utilities, Parks & Recreation, Streets/Highways, Public Works, Buildings/Maintenance, Police/Public Safety
