RENSELAER CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT BOX 29-02 - 24 HOUR MUTUAL AID CITY WIDE

- 1. Consistent with County Mutual Aid Policy all Mutual Aid response requests will be routed only through County Dispatch.**
- 2. Rensselaer Dispatch - Rensselaer FD units on scene or Battalion 70 will make request as: Second Alarm Box 29-02 with the address specified.**
- 3. Battalion 70 will coordinate communications with County Dispatch on South Fire Dispatch (4-1), other responding County staff may assist.**
- 4. Responding Mutual Aid Companies will communicate with County Dispatch on 3-1 or 12-15.**
- 5. Responding Mutual Aid Companies will use County OPS 8 (3-8, 4-8, 12-8) for Operations and 12-3 or 5-1 for Fireground Operations.**
- 6. Mutual Aid Companies can communicate with Rensselaer Dispatch on 14-5.**
- 7. Second Alarm Assignments as follows:**
 - Station 8: Squad to scene - Engine to Broadway Station for cover**
 - Station 9: FAST Team to Scene - Engine to North Station for Cover**
 - Station 11: Engine and Truck-11 to scene**
- 8. Third Alarm Assignments as follows:**
 - Station 6: Engine to Broadway Station for cover**
 - Station 8: Engine from Broadway cover assignment and Truck 8 to scene**
 - Station 9: Engine from North Station cover to scene**
 - Station 42: Engine to North Station for cover**
- 9. Fourth Alarm is Special Call by the Incident Commander.**
- 10. Cover assignment companies should be prepared for EMS responses.**
- 11. Rensselaer Dispatch may use 14-5, or notify County Dispatch to dispatch cover companies to additional incident. Companies at RFD North Station are to monitor Fire Dispatch and 14-5 at all times.**
- 12. Incident Command may modify response assignments at any time. County Dispatch should be advised of any changes made directly by Command.**
- 13. Operational changes may be made by the Incident Commander, in coordination with the Mutual Aid Chiefs and Senior County Staff on scene.**
